Q: How do I sign up for Hope Services Programs?

A: You can register with Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) or the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD), then choose Hope Services to be your provider. For self-pay and scholarship options please contact Hope Services directly.

Q: What is Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)?

A: Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) is a federal/state program that helps people who live with physical or mental disabilities get or keep a job. VR is committed to helping people who live with disabilities find careers.

Q: If I do not have VR Services, do I still qualify?

A: You may qualify for services through our self-pay or scholarship programs. Please contact Hope Services for more information.

Q: Do I have to pay for Hope Services Programs?

A: We have options depending on qualifications including funding through Vocational Rehabilitation (VR), self-pay or scholarship programs.

Q: Can Hope Services guarantee me a job?

A: For the past two decades, we have successfully placed thousands of clients with hundreds of employers. We know what it takes to find the right job for you.

Q: What if I do not have any experience?

A: No experience required! We encourage you start with our work readiness/pre-placement training course to reduce any anxiety by gaining confidence through resume writing, becoming interview ready, handling conflict, and knowing where and how to obtain a job.
